# Roly Poly Penguins Flannel

Fabrics from the Roly Poly Penguins Flannel collection by Barb Tourtillotte for Clothworks **Not For Resale**

## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

- 7/8 yard Blue Stripe (Y0805-31)
- 1-1/8 yards Red Snowflake (Y0806-4)
- 1-3/8 yards Green Snowflake (Y0806-24) (inc. binding)
- 1 yard Blue Snowflake (Y0806-31)
- 5/8 yard Red Penguins (Y0807-4)
- 5/8 yard Blue Penguins (Y0807-31)
- 3-1/4 yards Backing of choice

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric  
LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Blue Stripe cut:

7 – 3-1/2" x WOF strips (border)

### From the Red Snowflake cut:

6 – 2" x WOF strips (border)

34 – 4-1/2" squares

### From the Green Snowflake cut:

7 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips (binding)

12 – 6-7/8" squares-cut once diagonal

9 – 5-1/4" squares-cut twice diagonal

### From the Blue Snowflake cut:

12 – 6-7/8" squares-cut once diagonal

6 – 4-1/2" squares

9 – 5-1/4" squares-cut twice diagonal

### From the Red Penguins cut:

6 – 9" squares

### From the Blue Penguins cut:

6 – 9" squares

### Making the Penguin Block

1. Sew to one side of a red penguin 9" square a blue snowflake triangle cut from the 6-7/8" squares (Figure 1). Press the seam outward and add three more triangles to the remaining sides of the square. Press the 12-1/2" block and repeat to make six red penguin/blue snowflake blocks and six blue penguin/green snowflake blocks.

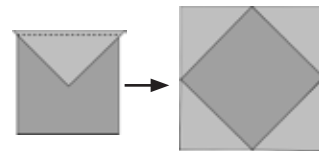

### Making the Pieced Sashing

1. Layout two green snowflake triangles and two blue snowflake triangles cut from the 5-1/4" squares (Figure 2). Sew the triangles together into a 4-1/2" hourglass unit. Repeat to make and press 17 hourglass units. Two triangle units will be leftover.
2. Sew into a row one red snowflake 4-1/2" square, one hourglass unit and one red snowflake (Figure 3). Press the seams toward the red snowflake squares and repeat to make 17 completed sashing units.

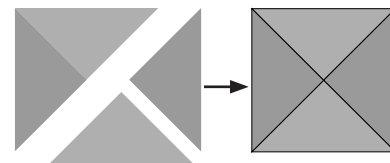

### Sewing the Quilt Center Together

1. Layout the blue and red penguin blocks and the sashing units as shown in the quilt picture. Sew the blocks and sashing into five vertical rows. Sew the rows together and press the seams toward the sashing - away from the large blocks.

### Adding the Borders

1. Measure the length of the quilt center and piece and trim two borders from the red snowflake 2" wide x WOF strips to that length. Sew the borders to the left and right side of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
2. Measure the width of the quilt center and piece and trim two red snowflake borders to that length. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
3. Repeat to add the blue striped 3-1/2" wide strips for the outside border.

### Finishing the Quilt

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top and baste for quilting. Quilt as desired and trim off the excess backing and batting from around the outside border.
2. Make the binding and apply to the quilt.
