Gnome Parade 2 1/2" Strip Roll ST0370	1 roll	10 rolls	20 rolls
Background: Light Butter Dots Y3502-58	3 1/2 yards	3 bolts	5 bolts
Accent: Red Solid AMB-82	1 1/2 yards	1 bolt	2 bolts
Border 1: Light Butter Gnomes Y3500-58	5/8 yard	1 bolt	1 bolt
* Border 2: Gnome Parade Pictorial Stripe Y3498-55 (yardage increased due to pictorial stripe; cut LOF)	2 1/4 yards	2 bolts	3 bolts
Binding: Denim Dots Y3502-88	2/3 yard	1 bolt	1 bolt
Backing: White Gnomes Y3500-1	5 1/3 yards	4 bolts	8 bolts

*To make quilt as shown with continuous unpieced Border 2, cut along the length of the fabric. You will need (2) 6 1/2" x 76" strips for the left and right side, and (2) 6 1/2" x 66" for the top and bottom. When cutting, center each strip along the portion of stripe you wish to highlight (see picture for guidance). We call for extra yardage to ensure you can place the motifs in a pleasing arrangement. Continue construction of quilt top per pattern.

Fabrics

Gnome Parade 2 1/2" Strip Roll ST0370	1 roll
Background: Light Butter Dots Y3502-58	3 1/2 yards
Accent: Red Solid AMB-82	1 1/2 yards
Border 1: Light Butter Gnomes Y3500-58	5/8 yard
* Border 2: Gnome Parade Pictorial Stripe Y3498-55 (yardage increased due to pictorial stripe; cut LOF)	2 1/4 yards
Binding: Denim Dots Y3502-88	3/8 yard
Backing: White Gnomes Y3500-1	5 1/3 yards

**To make quilt as shown with continuous unpieced Border 2, cut along the length of the fabric. You will need (2) 6 1/2" x 76" strips for the left and right side, and (2) 6 1/2" x 66" for the top and bottom. When cutting, center each strip along the portion of stripe you wish to highlight (see picture for guidance). We call for extra yardage to ensure you can place the motifs in a pleasing arrangement. Continue construction of quilt top per pattern.*
