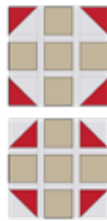


Hopscotch Happy

Materials Usage Notes With 5" OR 10" Square pack!



Used in HST units. Each 10" square (or set of four 5" squares) makes two sets of HST units that are used in two blocks. For variety, we used some 10" squares only one time (only two 5" squares needed for these positions).

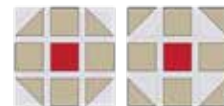


Charts show fabric usage for 42-piece 10" square pack. For 5" square pack, use four squares of each fabric shown.

Fabrics are displayed according to block placement. When a single 10" square is subcut, subsequent use is shown outlined in yellow.



Used in centers. Each 10" square makes up to 4 centers. (Use one 5" square for each center.)



Used in side squares. Each 10" square makes one set of four (use four 5" squares). Each set of four is used to make one block.
