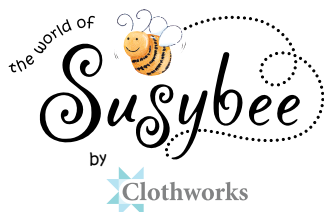


Kitty Dash

Fabric & Cutting Chart

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
 <p>Fabric A SB20053-101</p>	1y	<p>a. Pieced blocks and sashing pieces</p> <p>(3) 1" x WOF strips. Cut (2) 1" x 15 1/2" strips from (1) WOF strip. Cut (2) 1" x 26 1/2" strips from remaining (2) WOF strips.</p> <p>(5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips from (1) WOF strip. Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" and (2) 1 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips from remaining (4) WOF strips.</p> <p>(1) 3" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 3" x 3" and (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.</p> <p>(5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (24) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>b. Inner border #1</p> <p>(5) 2" x WOF strips. Cut (2) 2" x 33 1/2" from (2) WOF strips. Piece remaining (3) strips and subcut (2) 2" x 42 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric B SB20157-810</p>	3/8y	<p>a. Square pieced blocks</p> <p>(5) 1" x WOF strips. Subcut (24) 1" x 7 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>(1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric C SB20390-100</p>	1 yard	<p>a. Pieced blocks</p> <p>(1) 15 1/2" x 25 1/2" rectangle from panel rectangular, centering design.</p> <p>(6) 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares from panel squares, centering designs.</p>
 <p>Fabric D SB20392-725</p>	1/2y	<p>a. Outer border</p> <p>(5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" strips from (2) WOF strips. Piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 47 1/2" strips.</p>

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 Fabric E SB20393-150	1/4y	a. Inner border #2 (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips from (2) WOF strips. Piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" strips.
 Fabric F SB20393-430	1/4y	a. Pieced block (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" from (1) WOF strip. Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" from remaining (2) WOF strips. (1) 3" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 3" x 3" squares.

Constructing rectangular pieced block

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" *Fabric A* square. Place square right sides together, on (1) 3" x 3" *Fabric F* square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degree angle line on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished. Make a total of (4) HST units.



2. Sew (1) 1" x 15 1/2" *Fabric A* strip to the left and right sides of 15 1/2" x 25 1/2" *Fabric C* rectangle, followed by (1) 1" x 26 1/2" *Fabric A* strip to the top and bottom of the same *Fabric C* rectangle. Unit measures 16 1/2" x 26 1/2" unfinished.



3. Sew together (1) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" *Fabric A* strip and (1) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" *Fabric F* strip to make a strip unit. Make a total of (2) strip units, and sew to the left and right sides of step 2 unit.



4. Sew together (1) 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" *Fabric A* strip and (1) 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" *Fabric F* strip to make a strip unit. Make a total of (2) strip units. Add (2) HST units made in step 1 to the opposite short sides of each strip unit, and sew to the top and bottom of step 3 unit to complete (1) rectangular pieced block. Block measures 20 1/2" x 30 1/2" unfinished.

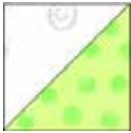


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Constructing pieced square blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* square. Place square right sides together, on (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric B* square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degree angle line on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure 2 " x 2 " unfinished. Make a total of (4) HST units.

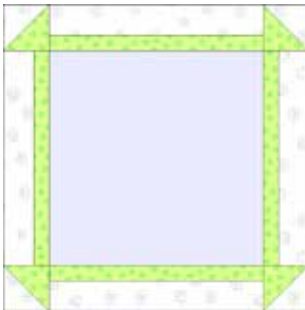


2. Sew together (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* rectangle and (1) 1 " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric B* rectangle to make a strip unit. Make a total of (4) strip units.

Sew (2) strip units to the left and right sides of (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric C* square.



3. Sew (2) HST units made in step 1 to the opposite short sides of each of the remaining strip units made in step 2, and sew to the top and bottom of step 2 unit to complete (1) block. Block measures $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make a total of (6) blocks.



Quilt Center Assembly

1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* strips to the top and bottom of rectangular pieced block.



2. Sew (3) pieced square blocks to make a pieced row. Make a total of (2) pieced rows, and add to the top and bottom of step 1 section to complete quilt center.



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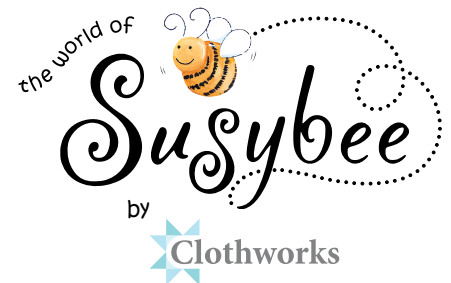
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Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 2" x 42 1/2" *Fabric A* strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x 33 1/2" *Fabric A* strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" *Fabric E* strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" *Fabric E* strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
3. Outer border. Sew (2) 2 1/2" x 47 1/2" *Fabric D* strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" *Fabric D* strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



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Finishing

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to finish quilt.
